Livonia Arts Scholarship Application 2026

There will be up to two scholarships for \$2,000 each awarded.

Eligibility: You must be a current resident of the city of Livonia AND a college student or a current high school senior who will be studying in an arts related field in the 2026-2027 school year.

Requirements:

1. Acceptance as a full-time student at an accredited college or university. (Must provide verification of acceptance and be prepared to furnish a course plan of credits.)
2. Copy of High School/College transcripts: to be included with the application.
3. Two or three letters of recommendations, choosing from the following categories: a current or recent teacher, employer/clergy/private instructor/coach, a non-related individual. No more than one letter from each category will be accepted.
4. Finalists will be required to submit examples of their work. All applicants will receive an email by March 13, 2026, informing them of the decision made by the committee.

Deadline: Must be either postmarked or received via email to arts@livonia.gov no later than Monday, February 23, 2026.

* Scholarships may be awarded to individuals no more than twice.
