

City of Livonia
Policy on Accepting Legal Tender

The City of Livonia accepts the following for obligations due to the City of Livonia: Cashier's Check, Money Order, a check drawn on a Business, Corporation, Personal bank account only if the check is issued from a United States of America Bank or, if issued from a foreign bank, that the check is issued payable in United States of America Funds. The City of Livonia does not accept third party checks as valid legal tender. A check returned as uncollected by the issuing bank for any reason will incur a returned check fee as set by the City Council. The City of Livonia will only accept United States of America currency. No foreign currency will be accepted. Coins will be accepted as payment only in the following amounts: Unrolled pennies not to exceed \$.50, unrolled nickels not to exceed \$2.00, unrolled dimes not to exceed \$5.00, unrolled quarters not to exceed \$10.00, half dollars not to exceed \$10.00 and dollar coins not to exceed \$25.00. All amounts above these amounts must be in a bank coin wrapper containing the customer's name, address and telephone number on each rolled coin wrapper. Further, for transactions containing more than 20 rolls of coin, arrangements must be made in advance with the Treasurer's Office prior to bringing the rolled coins in for payment.
