Barrows, David	Sgt. Co. M. 1 st Mich. E. and M. Marker no death date
Barrows, Nelson J.	Co. E. Mich Infantry No death date, just marker
Bassett, Glen E.	Grave G.A.R. marker b. 1887 d. 1908
Brown, Chauncey G.	Co. I. 21 st Mich. Infantry Age 81 yrs. 2 mo. d. Mar. 20, 1907
