



Situational Awareness

- Wayne County announces 19 new Livonia residents have tested positive for COVID-19 in the last 24 hours. Seven new deaths related to COVID-19 in Livonia were also reported.
- The State of Michigan announces 2,589 new individuals have tested positive for COVID-19 in cases reported to the state in the last 24 hours.
- St. Mary Mercy Hospital is currently treating 38 patients for COVID-19, including nine in intensive care. Statewide, 3,304 adults are hospitalized for COVID-19.
- More than 50% of Michigan residents and 56% of non-Detroit Wayne County residents have received at least one dose of a COVID-19 vaccine.
- New Michigan Department of Health and Human Services guidance holds that those attending outdoor gatherings of fewer than 100 people are not required to wear a mask during residential gatherings. Fully vaccinated individuals may also safely remove their mask at indoor residential gatherings. For more information on epidemic order changes, visit the State's [website](#).
- Through May 17, the vaccination center at Detroit's Ford Field will be offering one-dose Johnson & Johnson COVID-19 vaccines as well as second doses of Pfizer vaccines for anyone who needs it, regardless of where their first dose was received. The site is now accepting walk-ins and is open from 8:30 a.m. to 7:00 p.m. To date, more than 229,000 doses have been administered at Ford Field.

Actions Taken

- Livonia firefighters as part of the Vaccinate Livonia program administered more than 700 doses of COVID-19 vaccines today at the Civic Park Senior Center.
- The City of Livonia releases an updated version of "What's Open in Livonia," a [guide](#) to the status of City services and programs that may be affected by the pandemic and COVID-19 restrictions.
- The City of Livonia has updated [VaccinateLivonia.org](#), a hub for information about COVID-19 vaccine appointments in our area. Currently, 24 pharmacies in Livonia are providers of COVID-19 vaccines.
