



Situational Awareness

- Wayne County announces eight new Livonia residents have tested positive for COVID-19 in the last 24 hours. In the last seven days, 46 Livonia residents have tested positive and five new deaths from COVID-19 in Livonia were reported.
- The State of Michigan announces 1,560 new individuals have tested positive for COVID-19 in cases reported to the state in the last 24 hours.
- According to Michigan Department of Health and Human Services data, 56.8% of Michigan residents age 16 or older have received at least one dose of a COVID-19 vaccine. In Wayne County, 57% of those age 12 or older have received at least one dose of a vaccine.
- A U.S. Department of Agriculture program will expand eligibility among Michigan residents for additional food assistance in response to COVID-19. For additional information, visit the MDHHS [website](#).
- Michigan's Unemployment Insurance Agency will reinstate work search requirements for unemployment benefit claimants starting May 30, 2021. The requirement was previously suspended during the pandemic.
- The rate of new cases of COVID-19 is decreasing in all 50 states. As of May 18, there have been roughly 33 million cases and 587,000 deaths from COVID-19 in the United States. Over the last 14 days, daily new cases have decreased by about 38% and daily new deaths have decreased by about 16%.
- The Wayne County Health Department can provide residents with a replacement COVID-19 vaccination card if the original has been lost or destroyed. A resident may request a replacement card by calling (734) 727-7100.

Actions Taken

- The City of Livonia releases an updated version of "What's Open in Livonia," a [guide](#) to the status of City services and programs that may be affected by the pandemic and COVID-19 restrictions.
- The City of Livonia has updated [VaccinateLivonia.org](#), a hub for information about COVID-19 vaccine appointments in our area. More than two dozen pharmacies in Livonia have available appointments.
- Livonia Fire & Rescue through the Vaccinate Livonia program administered approximately 16,500 doses of COVID-19 vaccines to residents.
