# BULK LEAF PICKUP PROGRAM

## Keep a Safe Distance

It is difficult to see residents when they are trying to rake leaves in the street while they are being picked up by heavy equipment.

## Leaves Only

Don't place sticks, grass or anything other than leaves in your window.

## City Only Picks Up Leaves from the Street

Avoid piling leaves by mailbox posts, street signs, decorative rocks or tight spots.

## City Will Take Most of Your Leaves

It's not possible for DPW crews to collect all of your leaves. Use yard waste collection for any leaves left behind.

## Rake Early

Schedules are tentative. Look for the red signs at neighborhood entrances. If crews finish an area early, they will move to other areas.

## Don't Place Leaves in the Street After Final Pickup

The leaf equipment must be converted for snow removal and cannot make return trips for leaves.

## Rake Leaves into a Long

Windrow In Front of Your Home  
Don't make one big pile. Don't block gutters or drainage ditches.

## Yard Waste Must Be in Marked Cans or Paper Compost Bags

Place it out on your regular trash collection day through Dec. 8-12.

## UNBUNDLED BRUSH AND BRANCH PICKUP SERVICE ENDED FOR THE SEASON ON OCT. 3

Unbundled large branch and brush pickup will resume Monday, March 30, 2026.

Bundled branches can be disposed of with other yard waste in marked cans or paper compost bags on your regular trash collection day through the week of Dec. 8-12. Branches that fit can be placed in yard waste containers or bundled for collection. Up to five bundles may be placed out per week. Bundles must weigh less than 50 pounds each and the branches must be four feet or less in length.

Brush and branches may also be disposed of at Mid-Michigan Recycling on Glendale Avenue, Monday through Friday from 7 a.m. to 4:45 p.m. Residents with proof of Livonia residency, driving a personally owned vehicle, can dump items for free.




# 2025 BULK LEAF PICKUP PROGRAM SCHEDULE

Please be sure to place leaves out at the beginning of the scheduled week to ensure leaves are picked up. The City can only commit to two scheduled leaf pick-ups per section and will only visit each section once during the specified week.

Nov. 3-8: Sections 26, 27, 28, 32, 33, 20, 21, 22, 1, 12, 8, 17, 18 East of I-275, 35, 36, 9, 15
Nov. 10-15: Sections 10, 16, 34, 5, 6, 7, 18 West of I-275, 11, 14, 23
Nov. 17-22: Sections 2, 3, 4, 13, 24, 25, 26, 27, 28, 32, 33, 19, 30, 31, 20, 21, 22, 1, 12
Nov. 24-29: Sections 8, 17, 18 East of I-275, 35, 36, 9, 15
Dec. 1-6: Sections 34, 10, 16
